Choose ONE of the five public health programs listed below:

- A. A program to control any communicable disease.
- B. A program to control any "non communicable" chronic disease.
- C. A program to reduce complications of pregnancy and/or delivery.
- D. A program to reduce atmospheric pollution.
- E. A nutrition education program.

1. Design this program (in outline form) so that, after a period of time, its impact on the state of health could be evaluated. Be specific as to the objectives, and definitions and diagnostic criteria to be used for the state of health and the group and habitat characteristics. For each such characteristic indicate briefly the reasons for its selection. (Administrative matters, such as budget and personnel, should be omitted from this examination.)
2. Now assume that the program has operated for 5 years. Present several tables showing the results. (The numbers in these tables can be made up by you).
3. Interpret these tables and indicate what conclusions you are able to draw.
