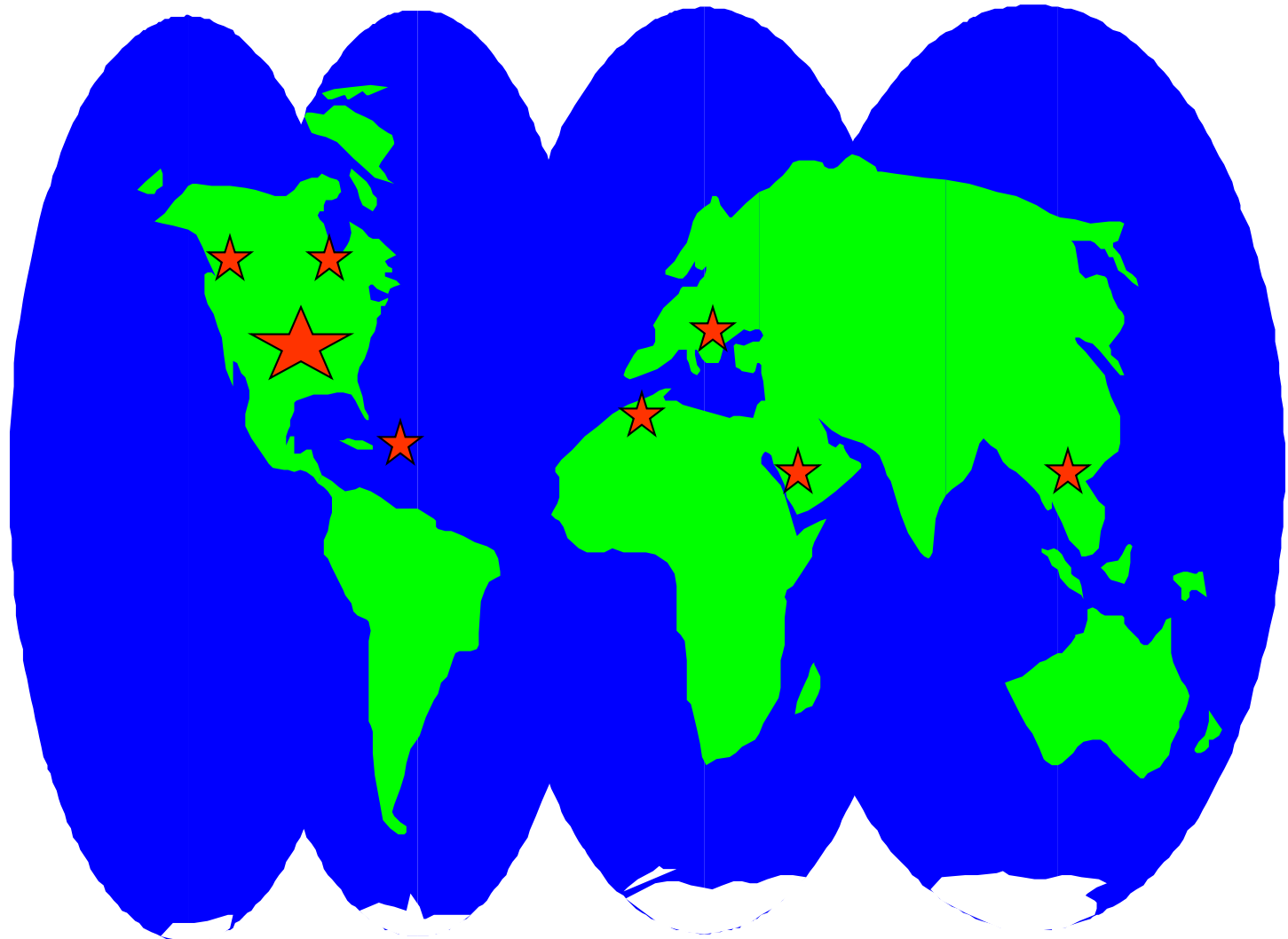
Epidemiology 160 -Students
