Stay straight to go onto Airport BLVD.

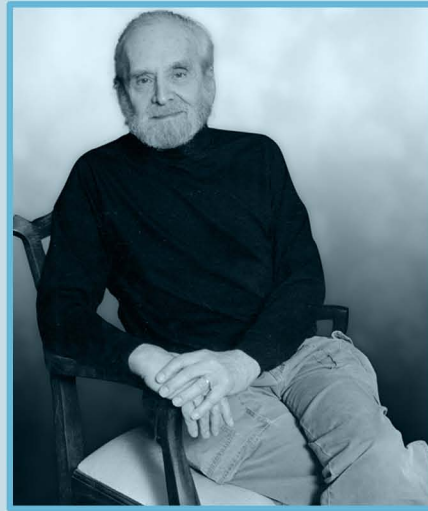
Merge onto I-40 W toward Durham/ Chapel Hill

Continue to follow.

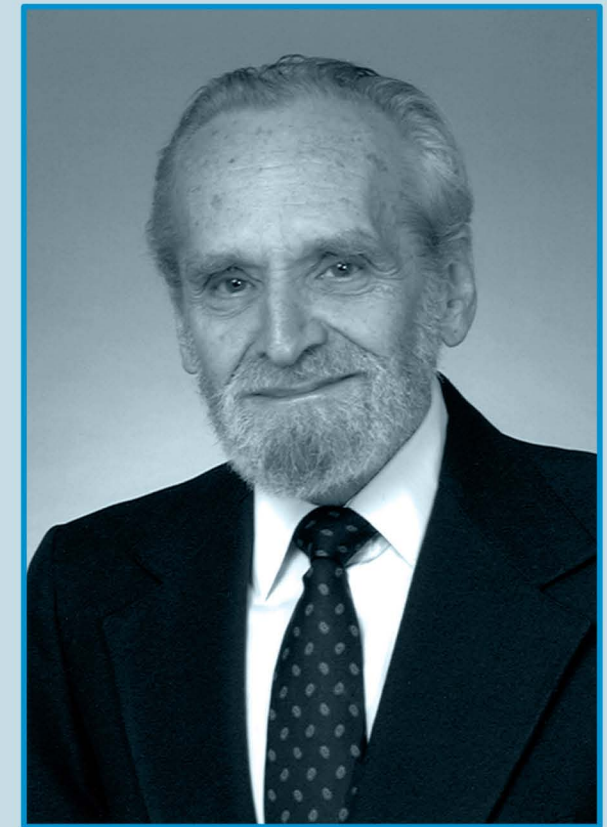
End at South Columbia Street.
